 - (a) Eating meat, fish, eggs, onion, garlic and any non-vegetarian food products;
 - (b) Taking all forms of intoxication including alcohol, drugs, tobacco, caffeine, coffee, tea, etc.;
 - (c) Doing gambling, highly speculative business investments and frivolous sports;
 - (d) Engaging in illicit sex in any form.
4. I vow to chant 16 rounds (16×108 mantras) of Hare Krishna Maha-mantra japa every day.
5. I vow that I shall follow the general and specific individual instructions given to me by my spiritual master _____ (spiritual master's name). I accept these instructions as representing Srila Prabhupada's Lord Krishna's will.
